
My most loving Father God! I praise You. I honor You. O Omnipotent God! Heavenly Father, You who are filled with immense Love! I Honor You and it is You I praise.

They blamed Jesus saying that He mentioned having to destroy the holy temple and that He would raise it up within three days. Having heard what Jesus revealed of Himself that He was the Messiah , that He would be seated at the right hand of God the Father, and that one day





Although everything was carried out so meticulously well, yet his friend Judas betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver coins. The leaders arrested Jesus and brought Him over to the court for judgment. They took Him to the government court under Pilate as though the court for the priests were insufficient.

They portrayed as if He were a political criminal. Finally Pilate questioned Him. That He was the Son of God, that He was the Messiah, that He would destroy the temple and revealed that He would rebuild it in three days, and that which was under the Jewish law they Portrayed as being against the Roman emperor, and thus accusing Him of heresy, they blamed Him unjustly. This was what Pilate had scrutinized and then came to a conclusion.

"I find no case against him." (John 18:38) "Look, I am bringing him out to you to let you know that I find no case against him.: (John 19:4) Pilate said to them, "Take him yourselves and crucify him; I find no case against him."

Thus Pilate a gentile publicly mentioned thrice that Jesus was blameless. Although Jesus was blameless, Pilate wanted to satisfy the general public and so had Him flogged with a whip, sentenced Him to death. Finally they killed Him by crucifying him on the Cross. It was only by the death on the Cross that Jesus gained His victory. Jesus hung on the wooden Cross and defeated satan that hung on the tree of the garden of Eden. Jesus defeated death by His own death on the Cross. By His selfless sacrifice and great love, Jesus won over man's selfishness and craftiness of satan. He won over death by His own death.

The disobedience of Adam was judgmental against human kind. But the obedience of Jesus granted Life to the human beings. (Romans 5:18-19) In this way we see that The agonizing Passion of Jesus Christ have become our strength and our Life. During these forty days of lent, let us make mortifications and pray. Jesus is seated at the right hand of God the Father and is ceaselessly interceding for us. (Romans 8:34)
